## WHAT IS MICROSOFT SINGLE BIGGEST INVESTMENT IN A COUNTRY IN THE LAST FORTY YEARS?



Microsoft announces A\$5 billion investment in computing capacity and capability to help Australia seize the AI era



Today Microsoft announced major digital infrastructure, skilling and cybersecurity investments in Australia to help the nation seize the artificial intelligence (AI) era to strengthen its economic competitiveness, create high-value jobs and protect the nation from the increasing threat of cyberattacks.

Microsoft will invest A\$5 billion in expanding its hyperscale cloud computing and AI infrastructure in Australia over the next two years - the single largest investment in its forty-year history in the country. This investment will also grow Microsoft's local datacenter footprint from 20 sites to a total of 29 spread across Canbera. Melbourne and Sydney.



## SECURITY IS SHAPING THE WORLD AND IMPACTING EVERY ORGANIZATION



The aged care sector will need 1 million extra workers by 2050 Technology will be a key factor to stay relevant

#### Ageing Population:

- 'The number of people aged over 65 is predicted to increase from 3.8 million to 5.2 million by 2027'.
- 85+ population is expected to increase by 360% by the year 2044
- The number of people who need the aged care service industry will continue to rise.



#### Increased Longevity:

- Australians are also living longer than ever before, thanks to health advancements.
- In 2018, over 2,600 people turned 100.
- In 2044, over 18,500 Australians are expected to turn 100.



#### Worker shortage:

- Australia is facing workers constraints in the sector to supply the demand.
  - 40 65% Turnover

- ageing at home,
- more personalized services, and
- higher levels of care.



#### Regulatory changes:

 Australia is pushing for regulatory changes in the sector.

## Frontline Workers in Not for Profit (NFP)

- Crucial role in providing direct support and assistance
- Supporting vulnerable people in society
- Disaster relief
- Labour shortages due to current economic climate
- Two out of three frontline workers reported that they were paid fairly but 80% faced financial challenges due to rising costs\*
- High attrition rates due to the nature of the work
- Re-training staff and re-hiring a major ongoing cost with 30% being replaced year on year

- Limited access to up-to-date information
- Communication barriers within and across teams
- Long shifts
- Stressful roles 'on the go'
- At home 'consultations'
- Quick, simple tools and access to systems imperative






